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As of January 2017, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) began covering outpat ent dialysis treatments for pat ents with acute kidney injury (AKI). As a result:

- Medicare-cert f ed ESRD dialysis centers are now paid by CMS for providing outpat ent dialysis services to AKI pat ents that already have Medicare.
- CMS reimburses nephrologists to care for dialysisdependent AKI pat ents with Medicare as outpat ents. CMS has not restricted the frequency of direct physician evaluat on for this unique set of pat ents.
